Earthborn Ecopro Silicate Masonry System is suitable for use on any porous mineral substrate, chemically bonding to form a durable, water and weather resistant barrier, whilst allowing the wall to breathe.

Available in a palette of 24 standard colours.

PREPARATION AND APPLICATION

First remove any loose or flaking material and ensure that all surfaces are clean, dry, sound, stable and algae free.

Step 1. Apply a coat of Ecopro Silicate Primer

Step 2. Apply a coat of Earthborn Ecopro Silicate Masonry Paint, diluted with 20% Ecopro Silicate Primer

Step 3. Apply a final coat of Earthborn Ecopro Silicate Masonry Paint

NOTE Do not use if the temperature is below 8°C or expected to fall below 8°C within 24 hours of application. Earthborn Ecopro Silicate Masonry Paint should not be applied over conventional 'plastic' masonry paints. Some clay surfaces may require special treatment.

The West Lodge

PADDINGTON CEMETRY

The listed Victorian lodge had previously been poorly repaired using conventional cement and non-breathable paint

Old paint was removed and the property sympathetically restored

Earthborn's Ecopro Silicate System in the colour 'Portland' was applied, blending the original building with its red brick extension and allowing the walls to breathe

Stone Cottage

THE COTSWOLDS

Early 1800s Cotswold stone cottage

The owners have restored it using lime and breathable Earthborn Ecopro Silicate Masonry Paint in the colour 'Buttermilk'



Merchant's House

STROMNESS, ORKNEY

Former merchant's house situated in the conservation area of Stromness

The property is coated with harling, a traditional Scottish render made from aggregate and lime

Walls were cleaned and residual paintwork removed before applying the Ecopro Silicate Masonry System in a bespoke colour



Medieval Hall House

NORTH DEVON

Grade II listed medieval house built around 1550 using Devon cob and lime plaster

The property was previously coated in limewash which needed to be re-applied every three years

Earthborn's Ecopro Silicate Masonry System was chosen in the colour 'Sandstone' as a long lasting, breathable alternative to limewash



Haxton Cottage

WILTSHIRE

Traditional cottage constructed using a mix of materials including chalk cobb, brick and flint but the property suffered a range of problems caused by inappropriate repairs

Cement render and non breathable masonry paint were removed and replaced with lime and breathable Ecopro Silicate Masonry Paint in the colour 'Pebble'



Old Windmill

BARNHAM, SUFFOLK

Originally built in the 1820s the windmill had suffered with damp for much of its life

In attempt to seal out moisture the building was coated in tar and non-breathable acrylic masonry paint, resulting in damaged walls and blown paint

All coatings were removed and walls repaired, then breathable Ecopro Silicate Masonry System applied in the colour 'York'



Moreton House

BIDEFORD, DEVON

Grade II listed Georgian country house

Undergoing an extensive programme of restoration including stripping back and lime rendering exterior walls using Earthborn's Ecopro Silicate Masonry Paint



Somerset House

SOMERSET

Period property rendered with natural hydraulic lime then painted with the breathable Ecopro Silicate Masonry System
