The letters should have a narrower profile to not protrude so far from the fascia. We have supported 5cm including the pins at sites in close proximity
The section drawing will need to be amended to provide further detail of the halo illumination;
The bulb should be shown attached to the back of the face of the letter
The sides and face of the letter should be shown as opaque with the rear clear
