Description of Works: TREE PRESERVATION ORDER - HOWDEN NO.3 - 1989 (REF.25) - Remove two Scots Pine trees that have blown over and fell four Scots Pine trees due to close proximity to properties had safety concerns that they will also blow over

I write further to the approval of the above tree works application. The notice of decision dated March 2014 required a replacement tree be replanted.

We would be grateful if you could confirm that this condition has been complied with by providing details of the replacement tree(s) planted. This should include the species, size and location of tree(s). You may also wish to include a photograph as evidence.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind you that if, within a period of five years from the date of planting, the tree(s) or any other tree(s) planted in replacement for it (them) is removed, uprooted, destroyed or dies, another tree(s) of the same size and species shall be planted at same place, or in accordance with any variation for which the Local Planning Authority give their written consent.
