Condition 8 - Front vehicular access to remain as it is; to allow for occasional retail space EV charging amenities to be available at the front part of the retail section if needed. Vehicles are able to access this area via the front bi-fold doors and this space could provide this much needed amenity.

Condition 9 - Additional windows on ground floor and stairwell area. As per the advice from building control, these areas require more natural light (and AOVs to stairwell) and the view from each proposed window will not encroach on any neighbouring properties.
Condition 2 - Ground floor is materially the same. However the residential and commercial entrances and amenities have been separated as opposed to sharing spaces. This is using a mezzanine area to provide more convenient use and fire escape strategies (as per latest fire safety surveys).
