I acknowledge receipt of your application for Advertisement Consent dated 14th September 2021. However, I regret that I cannot accept your application as valid for the following reasons:-

- 1. You have not submitted a location plan. Please submit a location plan to a scale of 1:2500 or 1:1250 with the boundary of the site to be developed clearly outlined in red showing a north point and at least two named roads and surrounding buildings or where the application site is in the countryside, the situation of the application site in relation to the locality and 'neighbouring land'. Properties shown should be numbered or named. The purpose of the location plan is to ensure that the exact location of the application site is clear. Please also ensure the location plan contains an appropriate Ordnance Survey licence/serial number.
- 2. The block plan you have submitted do not seem to be to the correct scale as annotated. This means we are unable to measure your plans electronically and accurately assess your proposed works. Please note that a page size is not

- applicable in terms of electronic plans as the plans should be created to the correct page size when exported.
- 3. You have not submitted detailed plans and elevations at 1:50 or 1:20 for sign 1B. Please submit such plans demonstrating its size, method of construction, type of illumination (if relevant), colour and materials.

Please Note: any subsequent documents or information should be sent to us via the online planning portal at <a href="https://www.eplanning.scot/">https://www.eplanning.scot/</a>. We will only accept additional information to your application using the Post Submission Additional Documents (PSAD) process. We will no longer accept emails.

Additional information received after 21 days will invalidate any Land Ownership Certificate – if this was completed. This must be dated within 21 days, and is a legislative requirement. Furthermore, any information that is not submitted electronically, will also delay your application.
