Steel frame building of dimension 15M X 20M. Base of the walls will be 2m high, (2x1m high) 5M Length concrete panels, of 100mm thickness. Dark green ventilated cladding above the concrete panels up to the roof. Roofing is big 6 profile fibre cement sheets with a Perspex sky light in each bay for providing natural light. Black PVC guttering will be used.
