The Site

The property is accessed directly from St Osyths Lane, there is rear access to the property via a shared passage to the northern boundary; the garden is enclosed.

The Proposal / Layout

It is proposed to replace the rear Collyweston slate with Winchcombe slates; the rear roof is in a deteriorating state with water ingress into the roof space of the listed dwelling.

Appearance / Impact

The listing of the dwelling as described is 'Late C18. 2 storeys in ashlar with modern cement tile roof. 2 windows to both floors, hung sashes in shallow reveals, flat arched heads. Central doorway, moder door'. The proposed replacement of the rear Collyweston roof with a replacement modern simulation will not impact on the described listing as it is not visible from St Osyths Lane (front) or East Road (rear). Other rooves in the immediate locality are blue slate, Collyweston slate and Collyweston style heritage roofing.
