T1: Sugar Maple- Fell to ground level due to poor condition and close proximity to well used area.

T2: Ash- Deadwood removal and removal from canopy and 2-3m side reduction on aspect of tree extending over lawn.

T3: Ash-Deadwood removal and removal from canopy and 2-3m side reduction on aspect of tree extending over lawn. Removal of 2x lowest limbs extending towards Yew tree to promote growth of Yew tree and eliminate competition. **The Old Rectory Riverside Farm Lane Tichborne SO24 0NA**
