



GD2 Door Vertical Section - 1:2






Typical Casement Vertical Section - 1:2



Typical Casement Horizontal Section - 1:2




Elevations - 1:20




GD2 Door Horizontal Section - 1:2

## General Joinery Notes (covering all related joinery sheets).

Good quality hardwood to be used. e.g. Sapele or similar for painted joinery, to be approved. Glazed Doors with painted finish to be constructed of Accoya

4mm toughened glass bedded in traditional natural linseed based putty

Doors and adjacent sidelights/windows in critical locations within 1500mm of ground and floor level, and 300mm of doors and windows within 800mm of floor/ground to be safety glazed (toughened) to: BS EN 12150, BS EN 14179 and BS EN 14449

Final sizes of all openings to be verified upon setting out prior to construction. Vertical glass proportions to be maintained, consult Designer with any changes of size that may occur. At rebated openings, take special care to ensure continuity of weatherseal. Allow for proprietary weatherseals, grooves shown on joinery are indicative. Capillary grooves to be incorporated, any shown are indicative. Any additional details and samples to be agreed with Designer.

Complete and full architraves to be used in all instances. Consult Designer at earliest opportunity if full architrave can not be

Where architraves terminate on a cill/threshold horns to cill/threshold to be 38mm past outer edge of architrave unless otherwise.

Ironmongery recesses to be machined off site as required.

All external doors to have laminated stiles, lower, mid and top rails.

Specification and storage considered with steps taken to minimise shrinkage and movement. Grain alignment to be considered to minimise the effect of shrinkage and movement.

Should joinery be stored on site prior to fixing, this to be done to minimise damage and deformation of timber.

Joinery to be decorated off site, excluding top finishing coat with proprietary primer and basecoats. No spray finishes (except primer)

Tops and bottoms of doors to receive painted finish. Ironmongery to remain spot free upon completion. Slotted screws to all visible

Timber thresholds to be unpainted and have Osmo clear UV-protection oiled finish.

All timber to be UKWAS or FSC certified.

Paint colours of all joinery to separate details, or to clients specification, as appropriate
