Works to Trees protected by Planning Conditions

Proposal: T1 - Oak - Remove deadwood and carry out a crown reduction of 2.5-3.0m to windfirm. Approximate height 14m
T2 - 2x chestnuts 13m to be removed due to proximity to building.
T3 - Fallen tree to be cleared.
