3. Please provide four copies of a drawing, to a recognisable scale, showing a section through the new extension.
4. Total fee for this application is £1386 - calculated based on the fish and chip shop with restaurant (calculated on floor space) and a new dwelling. Outstanding balance of £690 is payable.

6. Although you have confirmed that the site levels will remain unchanged, please provide a drawing indicating existing site levels across the site.
7. Please provide a plan indicating access.
8. From the 1st April 2016 the Habitats Regulations Monitoring and Mitigation Contribution levy came into force. The fee must be paid at the planning application submission stage or by entering into a Unilateral Undertaking / S106 agreement if you wish to pay later.

Therefore, a fee of £55 per dwelling, plus a £55 Administration Fee is payable on completion of a Unilateral Undertaking.

Payment in advance is charged at £55 per dwelling with no administration fee payable.

If you pay the fee via BACS - please quote the planning reference in the payment reference, to avoid delays.

Once this information is received your application will become valid and the application can be passed to the relevant planning officer.
