T4Sycamore- Remove epicormic growth to a height of 5m crown break  
T9Sycamore- Remove epicormic growth to 4m  
T10Sycamore- Remove epicormic growth to 4m  
T11Plane (London)- Remove and replant like for like specimen in next tree planting season 2021-22  
T12False Acacia- Remove epicormic growth to 6m  
T13Horse Chestnut (Red)- Remove epicormic growth to 4m  
T14Lime- Remove epicormic growth to 4m  
T15Lime- Crown lift to 6m. Remove poisonous mushrooms ASAP.  
T16Plane (London)- Crown lift to and remove trunk epicormic growth to 6m  
T17Hawthorn- Sever Ivy at 2m from ground level and remove section. Re-inspect. Crown lift and remove epicormic growth to a height of 4m.  
T19Poplar (Hybrid Black)- Crown reduce by 8-10m to previous pollard reduction points. Remove epicormic growth to a height of 8m to crown break. PICUS root crown to decay test trunk.  
T21Pissard Plum- Crown lift to 4m.  
T24Sycamore- Sever Ivy at 2m from ground level and remove section. Re-inspect. Remove epicormic growth to a height of 3m.  
T26Luccombe Oak - Fell close to ground level. Remove stump completely by grinding. Replace with large SM standard tree. (Exemption issued by WCC - 09.08.21)  
T27Horse Chestnut- Remove epicormic growth to a height of 6m. Remove dead wood. Crown lift low branches rubbing building by 2m.  
T33Pyracantha- Crown lift to 4m over footpath. Cut back by 3m over site.  
T35Cypress (Monterey)- Advise 3rd party tree owner to fell to ground level  
T37Horse Chestnut (Indica)- Crown lift to 4m over footpath.  
T38Cypress (Monterey)- Crown lift to 4m over footpath. Remove dead wood. Cut back by 4m over site.  
T39Cypress (Monterey)- Crown lift to 3m over footpath. Remove dead wood. Cut back by 4m overhanging branches. Removed hanging snapped limb.  
T43Ash (Common)- Fell / prune dead branches over site.  
T46Ash (Common)- Crown lift to 3m over site  
T48Cypress (Leyland)- Recommend to 3rd party tree owner to Fell to ground level.  
TG1Cypress (Leyland) - Cut back branches from building to give clearance of 2m.  
T50Buddleia- Fell and treat/grind stump  
T52Whitebeam- Remove dead wood. Cut back branches from building to give clearance of 1-2m.
