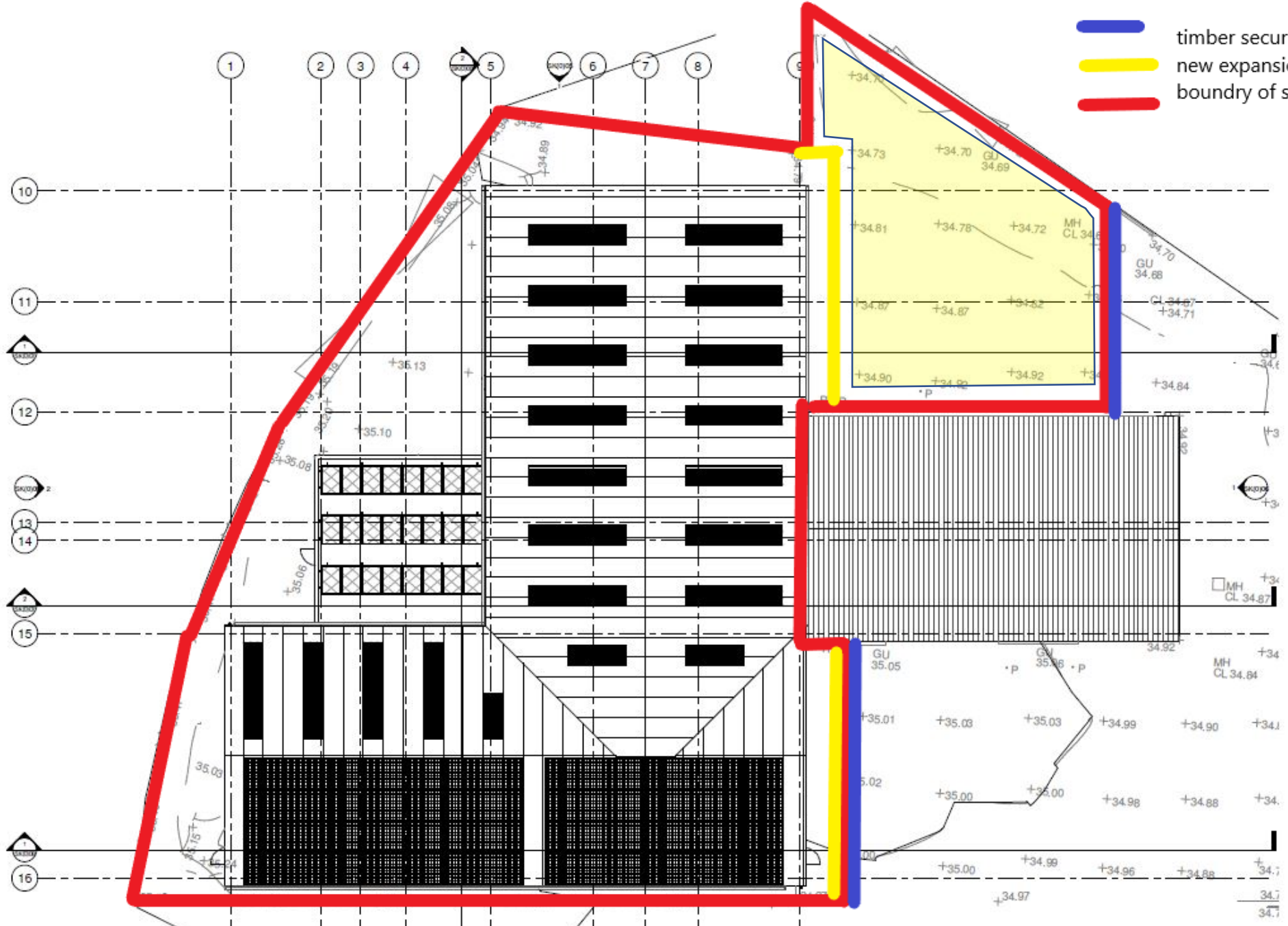

Existing Entrances / Roadways

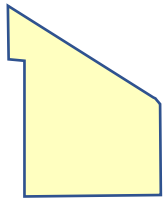


The photos in this slide depict the transport routes to be utilised on Haugh Way and noted site entrance as existing .

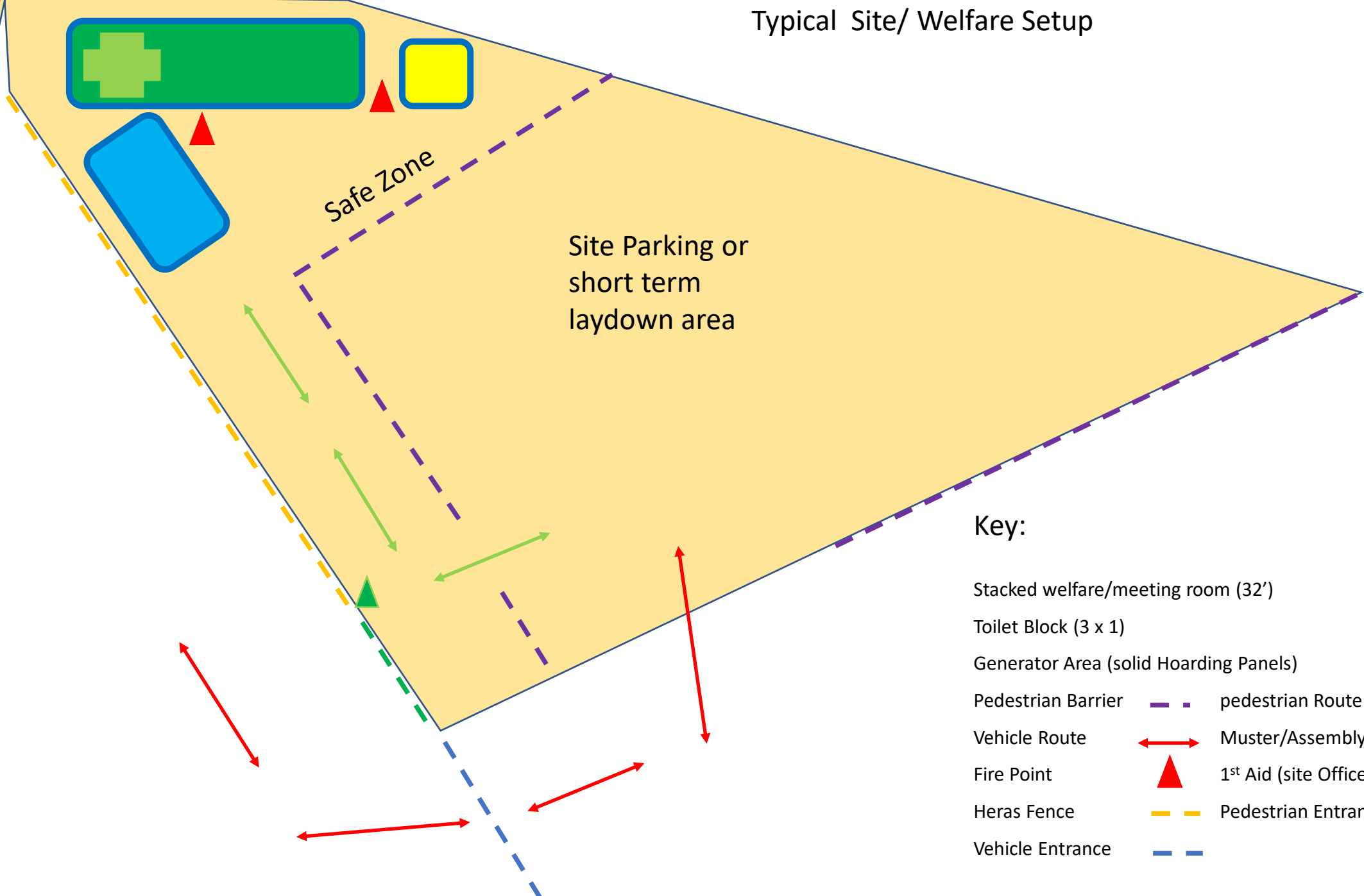
