Unfortunately I did not get the opportunity to fell the two dead trees last winter due to being let down by a couple of contractors; and I did not want to undertake any work in nesting season this year. Plus Covid had a bit of an impact in n getting these trees properly dealt with.

I have recently had a few people round to give quotes recently and all suggested that I request permission for a third tree which is dead and dropping sizeable branches near the highway. I've included photos below for your information.

The tree in question is circled in blue and a branch which has dropped is circled in red in both photos. I've also marked out the location on a map which illustrates the proximity to the road.
