e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

T1 - Removal of roughly three or four Lawson cypress to allow more airflow between the trees left and the cottage next door (The grange, Staveley) next door are having problems with damp within this area so its important more airflow is encouraged into this area. Also within T1 we plan to canopy raise some of the trees left behind, to increase the airflow further. We would like to remove everything within roughly 1.5 meters with the building.

T2 - Reduction of common Yew that appears to be in decline. Works done to encourage a more full canopy and prolong life.

T3 - Canopy raise of trees within this area to give more definition to to the trees from the garden below. Canopy raise of roughly two meters.

T4 - Removal of leylandii's to allow more light into the green house and garden and to give more of a formal look to the garden.
