T4 - Willow Tree - To remove the lower split limb remove deadwood over 4cm in diameter throughout the crown. To reduce the taller stem which is currently out of contact with the remaining crown down to a level to match the remaining. This stem has become dominant and the extra weight is likelt to cause stem failure. T8 Larch tree - Remove split branch.
