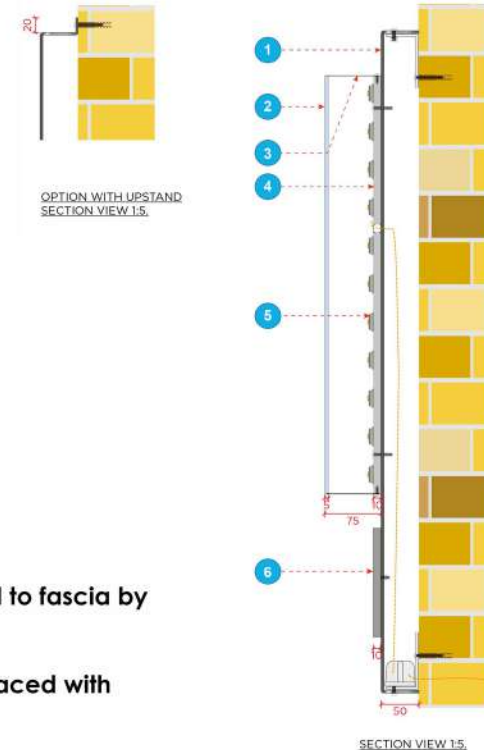

**DETAILS:**

- 2.5 mm thick alu' panels cut & folded to sizes shown & sprayed to Ral 9005 matt black fixed to fascia by way of alu' panel.
- Test faces from 5mm thick 1TL2 opal perspex with step rebate to rear for returns, spit to be faced with translucent orange vinyl to match to MT-636.
- 1mm thick pre-painted matt black aluminium returns(matt white internally bonded to perspex faces.
- 10mm thick black foamex backtrays with a step rebate and faced with matt white vinyl.
- White Optika 35 led's 6500k fitted to back trays with 12V power supply to go to box section.
- Sub text to be 10mm thick 069 white perspex stud fixed to panels.
