Hello

I am hoping I might be able to get some assistance in establishing how best to improve a grade 2 listed building in Walsingham. I realise I will need to make an application to make changes to the exterior of the building, but would like advice on what ideally it should look like.

The cottage is a bit of a scar on the street scape (admittedly in my opinion!), and does not seem to fit in with its surroundings due to a metal casement window that has been added at some stage (presumably pre listing).

I was hoping to be able to change the window back to something more sympathetic to its setting and more original if that's possible. I think the changes have caused some structural issues as well as the lintol above the window does not seem strong enough for the span.

I would be happy to discuss by phone and possibly meet on site if that were appropriate.

There are also further changes I would like to make which may be a bit more straightforward in terms of any applications but which would be good to discuss beforehand so I have a better understanding of what may be acceptable to yourselves.
