Comments

Developments of individual houses must include unobtrusive areas suitable to accommodating at least 3 x 240l wheeled bins.

The Joint Waste Service provides a kerbside collection service, therefore residents will be expected to present their bins at the nearest appropriate highway on collection days.

Unadopted roads/drives cannot be accessed by a collection vehicle if they are not constructed to an adoptable standard. Therefore a suitable bin collection point (BCP) may be required . The BCP can be a simple paved area but it must be sufficient to accommodate 3 x 240l bins for every property served by the private drive and be adjacent to the adopted highway to ensure an efficient refuse/recycling operation takes place. The inclusion of this in the plans is noted.
