Internal Alterations to be carried out by WDC  
Design and Access Statement

#### **Background**

The original building dates from the Georgian Period and is a Grade II Listed Building. The ground floor accommodation is currently used by Warwickshire Registration District, to carry out Wedding Ceremonies, and Warwick Town Council, including the Mayors parlour.

The first floor is due to be occupied by The Royal Regiment of Fusiliers, the second floor is currently occupied by WDC rangers and Live and Local.

Minimal internal alterations are proposed to allow the building to function correctly and effectively.

#### **Design**

The door on the first floor is to be removed to allow for the WWI experience as you progress through the museum. Removal will enable the wheelchair access through this exhibit and into the following section. Anything removed will be stored safely and replaced if the exhibitions change in the future.

The toilet provision at present does not provide adequate privacy in respect of the accessible toilet. Blocking up the gent's door opening, and providing a new entrance off the corridor, will enable the accessible toilet to have a more suitable entrance. All toilet facilities will be refurbished.

#### **Access**

Existing means of access to the front and rear of the property will remain.
