The following is minor pruning works required to maintain clearance from adjacent buildings and streetlight.

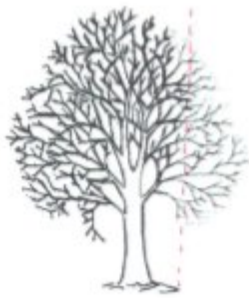
1. Robinia Prune to clear adjacent buildings by 2.5m, remove major deadwood, prune to clear street sign by 2m, remove major deadwood

Crown clearance



Crown clearance is the pruning back or the removal of branches that are encroaching towards an object such as a building/structure/lawn by a given amount. Good practice dictates crown lifting should not normally include the removal of large branches growing directly from the trunk as this can cause large wounds which can become extensively decayed leading to further long term problems or more short term instability. Crown clearance should be specified with reference to a fixed point, e.g. 'crown clear or prune back by 4m'.

All tree work is to be undertaken in accordance with good Arboricultural practice.
