Description Of Proposed Development: Compliance with Condition 14 (biodiversity enhancement scheme) of permission 21/03875/FUL - Erection of a single dwelling and associated works - Variation of Condition 2 (drawing numbers) of permission 20/03130/FUL to enable installation of additional rooflight and flues

Location: Avecote Kings Head Lane Withington Cheltenham

The above application was received by Cotswold District Council on 22 December 2021 and was not accompanied by an Environmental Impact Assessment with a formal Environmental Statement.
