Oak T13 - Remove broken limbs, prune back branches overhanging boundary to a suitably sized lateral. Horse Chestnut T14 - Prune back branches overhanging boundary to a suitably sized lateral. Ash T15 - Remove excessive lean, low amenity value. Cherry T16 - Remove, excessive lean.
Sycamore T17 - Remove, leaning, low amenity value.
Sycamore T18 - Remove, potential to cause issues with planned extension.
