This is a holly tree. It stands at the boundary of numbers one and two Church Row. With AVDC permission, most recently 20/00026/ATC, 21 January 2020, it has been reduced before at roughly two-year intervals. It is fast growing, causing shading and overbearing of the gardens of one and two Church Row, hence the need for regular intervention/reduction. Its current height is c.14/15 feet and spread (diameter) c.10 ft. The proposal is to reduce to a height of c. 10/11 feet and spread of c. 8ft while maintaining foliage and shape.
