Thank you for the email.

Interestingly I think I may be ahead of you here.

The tree has been dying for the last year or two which was a concern for us given that it helped block the view of a new building just the other side of the hedge at the end of the garden. In consequence I planted a crab apple tree to take over that role from the Goat Willow at such time as it had to be removed. The new tree is a few feet away from the Ash a little closer to the hedge at the far end of the garden. I hope that answers the question.

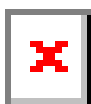
Dear Mr Rennison

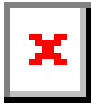
