SUPPORTING STATEMENT

SHED

This is a simple shed for gardening tasks but the intention is that it complements the architecture of the listed building.

A rectangular structure has been chosen and the window echoes the large windows of the house looking south.

The material of the shed mirrors the wood panelling on the main building. The shed will be a simple wooden frame, with walls of exterior quality ply with vertical battens, 2 cm x 2 cm fixed at 10 cm intervals. It will be painted in the same shade of charcoal grey as the equivalent wooden panels of the house.

The roof is a flat solid roof with aluminium trim that echoes that on the house.

FENCE

Fence posts will be held in the ground by postcrete. The vertical panels of fence and gate will be of treated wood. The fence will be 1.6 m high to be at the level of the boundary wall coping stones.
