



Site Plan showing Vehicle Tracking 1: 200





Ecology Legend.

IFF Schwegler Batbox with built in wooden rear panel. Positioned at a height of between 3-6 m and SW facing.

Habibat Barbox OOI, clad in material to match the elevation, built in to the structure.

Positioned 5-7 m above ground, near the eaves or gable apex of the property and SW facing.

Robin and wren diamond nestbox, positioned less than 2m above the ground in an area well hidden with vegetation.

House Sparrow Terrace FSC Nest Box placed between 1.5 and 5.5m above ground, prefrably near to vegetation.

Log Pile For Insects & Reptiles

The log pile will be sited away from living trees and shrubs in a semi-shady spot, it will comprise of any branches of trees that have fallen or been felled onsite. Piles should be fairly compact to maintain the humidity needed to decompose the wood.

<u>A – Wooden Bird box</u> Wooden bird box suitable for tits, sparrow or starlings to be fixed 2-4m up a tree or wall in a NE direction, tilted slightly forward so as to avoid the driving rain getting inside.

There will be a clear flight path to the nest without any clitter directly in front of the entrance.

m B-Bee\ Nesting\ Box}$ Bee nest box to be positioned in full sunshine, so facing SE or S and at

least Im from the ground. Placed near vegetation with no vegetation obscuring or shading the nest entrances and in a stable, fixed position that will not sway in the wind or be easily knocked or dislodged.
