Good afternoon Sandra. Hopefully the below will provide the clarification you require:

1. All of the new fencing and gates are indicated by way of different colours. These are included on drawing no: D03339/21/1/P03, D03339/21/1/P04 and D03339/21/1/P05. The new fencing and gates are coloured blue, red, yellow and green and a 'key' on the drawings describes what the different colours represent.
2. To the front of the site (adjacent Westgate Street), the new fencing and gates replaces the existing provisions and installation will be on the same lines as the existing fencing. To the east, south and west of the site, new fencing will be installed inside the existing fencing which is being retained.
