



External Lighting In order to avoid any unnecessary disturbance to bats in the future, any external lighting to be installed should:

- use Light emitting diodes (LED) luminaries
  have a warm white spectrum <27000 Kelvin (degrees colour temp)
  have peak wavelengths higher than 550nm
- be set on motion-sensors
- use short duration (e.g. one minute) timers not be in the vicinity of, or shine towards, bat roost openings
- not shine towards (the) roof structure(s)
- not be in the vicinity of, or shine towards, boundary vegetation

## Biodiversity Enhancement

Two Woodcrete bird box with 28mm access will be installed into a nearby tree at least 2m from the ground.
