

Planting Notes

1. Tree procurement, planting and management shall be in accordance with BS 8545:2014 Trees: from Nursery to Independence in the landscape-Recommendations.

2. All other plants shall be handled in accordance with 'Plant Handling', the booklet published by the Committee for Plant Supply and Establishment (CPSE). The contractor shall comply with clauses 3 & 4 of the above booklet (obtained from the Horticulture Trades Association, 19 High Street, Theale, Reading, Berks RG7 5H) which refers to the receipt, unloading and temporary storage of plants.

3. Plants shall be first class examples of their species or variety, free from all pests and diseases, with good fibrous root systems and materially undamaged (refer to relevant sections of BS3936 Parts I-4 'Specification of Nursery Stock').

4. All planting is to be in general compliance with BS4428: 1989 'Code of Practice for general landscape operations (excluding hard surfaces).'

5. Shrub beds to have a min depth of 450mm good quality topsoil, beds should be cultivated prior to planting and be free from weeds or any stones/ rubble material greater than 50mm

6. Standards are to be single-staked and secured with a rubber webbing tie and spacer.

7. For the ornamental trees; One number 80 litre bag of tree planting compost (non-peat based) is to be incorporated into tree pits. Compost must be mixed thoroughly with topsoil. Trees shall be planted in tree pits of the following minimum sizes (or large enough to comfortably accommodate the root ball, whichever is the largest):

Heavy Standard 800x800x650 deep

8. The contractor must ascertain for himself/herself the exact location of underground services and maintenance points.

9. All areas of ornamental planting are to be mulched to a depth of 50mm with medium grade tree bark.

10. The grassed areas will be seeded with a low growing species rich grass mix (unless otherwise advised by the client).

II. Water all plants and trees on the same day of planting and there after as necessary (min once a week in periods of drought) to ensure the establishment of the plants during the I2months defects period.
