Thank you for responding so promptly to my application. Firstly, I apologise for having not provided all the required information. This is my first time doing this.

For this application, I have made amendments so that I am no longer asking permission for the removal of the conservatory and the lean-to awning. For this, I will apply for separate planning permission so that it can be assessed on its own. In order to satisfy the requirement I will have to produce detailed architectural drawings which will take some time and the most pressing part of this application is the minor internal works now listed. Please may I apply for permission to start work on this for the time being?

The items contained within the application are now just internal works and the removal of the care home remnants. During the process of completing the online forms it didn't mention a heritage statement as being a mandatory document however the way ive written the access statement is broadly speaking the same thing. Ive amended this and uploaded it as a Heritage Statement as requested.
