#### SECTION 3 DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL

Brightlingsea Regent Football Club plan to replace the existing floodlights which are 40 years old with a new LED based system. Using 4 masts compared to the existing 6 masts. The current concrete bases will be replaced by new foundations of similar size (beneath ground), the existing fabricated metal masts will be replaced by new structures of similar size and appearance. The existing lights will be replaced by new LED lights.

There are currently 6 masts, one at each corner of the pitch and 2 sited on each side of the halfway line. 5 of these will be decommissioned and removed from the site, 1 will remain to continue as a site for mobile phone relays.

The new bases will each be no more than 1.6m square and the masts 15m high. The 4 new masts will be sited close to the locations of the existing corner based units.

LED lights offer superior capabilities to old designs:

They are more energy efficient.

They produce significantly less heat and UV light.

They are more environmentally friendly, unlike traditional lighting solutions they contain no mercury, lead or carbon.

They consume far less electricity and have a longer life with lower maintenance costs.

Overall the solution provides minimal visible change to the current mast and lighting footprint with new improved lighting technology.
