Conclusion/ planning balance

Based on the information provided, it is the view of planning officers that the proposal as submitted would require a householder planning application.

Should a formal householder planning application be submitted, it is considered that such a proposal would likely receive the support of planning officers, subject to submission of satisfactory plans (including proposed materials). The principle of the extensions off the dwelling is acceptable, but further details confirming the exact materials, measurements (and a scale), and location on site should be submitted on any future application to ensure it is of an appropriate scale and design. If a householder application was submitted, a site visit would be conducted to assess the existing dwelling and surrounding area whilst taking into account the proposed development. The proposal would unlikely raise significant concerns regarding residential amenity, nor would be likely to raise concerns of highway safety significant enough to warrant refusal.
