EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC STATION ROAD LEVEL CROSSING, EASTRINGTON

Notice is hereby given that East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding over Station Road Level Crossing, Easttrington during the following period **23.45 hours Saturday 14 May 2022 until 08.15 hours Sunday 15 May 2022**. ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 14 THE M18 MOTORWAY (JUNCTION 5) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that National Highways Limited has made an Order on the M18 Motorway, in Doncaster, to enable carriageway repairs works to be carried out in safety.

The works are expected to start on Monday 2 May 2022 for 1 night, or until completed, and will take place between 8pm and 5am. The effect of the Order will be, at times during the works, to close the M18 southbound entry slip road at Junction 5 (North Ings), during which times a suitably signed alternative route will be available.

Traffic signs will indicate the extent of the prohibition (which will not apply to emergency services vehicles, traffic officer vehicles or vehicles being used in connection with the said works or for winter maintenance purposes). EAST RIDING OF YORKSHIRE COUNCIL BELLASIZE LANE, BLACKTOFT (PART) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

East Riding of Yorkshire Council has made an Order the effect of which is to prohibit any person from causing any vehicle to proceed along part of Bellasize Lane, Blacktoft approximately 300 metres from the junction with Staddlethorpe Broad Lane for 70 metres. The reason for the closure is to enable the proposed Openreach works, to be carried out and completed in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. It is anticipated that the works will be completed within one day. The alternative route for traffic affected by the Order is via Bellasize Lane, Greenoak Lane, Blacktoft Lane, Sparrowcroft Lane and Staddlethorpe Broad Lane.
