Commenter Type: Neighbour Stance: Customer objects to the Planning Application Comment Reasons: Comment:No details regarding what the boundary between 4 & 6 Nesbitts Alley shown, what is being proposed? The current location of the bins and bike rack will significantly block our light to the lower floor unit of No. 6 Nesbitts Alley.

Cycle rack is very tall (taller than a boundary fence) with no accurate dimensions shown. How will it drain, it appear to drain onto our land.

Drawing shows 4 Nesbitts Alley as 6a, this is incorrect.

The cycle store and bins, located centrally in the courtyard will greatly impact on the front elevation of 6/6a Nesbitts Alley. We suggest that if one is required it should either be a low profile option or preferably against no. 4 Nesbitts Alley elevation. We strongly object to this proposal and would want to see a daylight study undertaken to justify it's location.
