Details of the pre-application advice received
In conclusion, the proposal for self-contained flats on the site would be considered acceptable in principle. However, the proposal would be wholly unacceptable in terms of massing and form. It is not considered to be of a design or form that could be supported. Amendments will be required in order to reduce the bulk and massing of the building and be compliant with Barnet's policies. This is in addition to issues raised above regarding concerns such as privacy and outlook. The comments detailed in the report above should be considered and addressed before progressing with the application.
