

Overview


This heritage statement supports a planning application for erection of a timber clad, garden room, with workshop and garage areas within the ground of Westburn House.

The Site

The site is situated South of St.Mary's Church and West of The Old Vicarage, the nearest listed buildings. The property itself is detached and set within its own grounds. The house itself is random course stonework with timber frame windows and doors. The position of the proposed garden room/garage is to be situated where existing structures currently sit to minimise the impact.
