Thank you for your letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> April 2022.

I've reviewed the content of the letter and I fear that the validator has not reviewed the top right-hand corner of the plan submitted with the application (attached for ease of reference). As you can see, there is a schedule of detailed pruning specifications that highlight that a selective reduction on the south canopies is proposed, as shown in the snip below, which includes the metres from branch tips to be removed, as well as the remaining canopy to be retained (metres from the trunk).

No canopy heights are referenced because the proposed pruning does not seek to reduce the heights of these trees.
