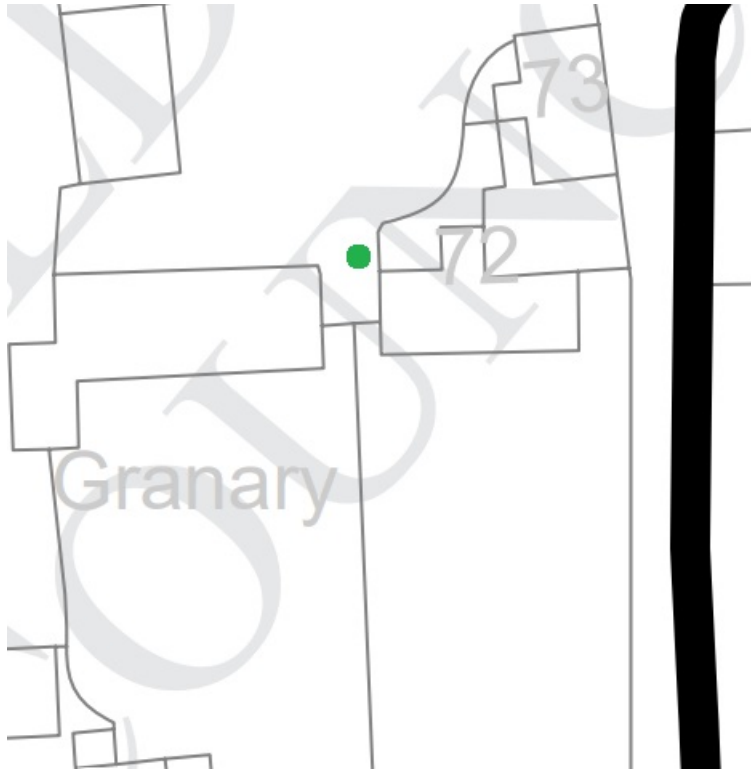


APPLICATION TO DO WORKS TO TREES IN A CONSERVATION AREA

Deodar Cedar at The Granary, Tarlton, GL7 6PA

Extract from Cotswold District Council's Conservation Area Map of Tarlton. North



T1: Deodar Cedar (Green Dot).

The application is to remove the 2 emerging codominant leaders. Subsequently to reduce the height to balance it (likely minimal, if at all) to create a new crown. Also to reduce the tree laterally by up to 30%, to improve light to the beds underneath and to reduce the tree's impact on the neighboring properties. In addition to crown lift to up to 4m to allow light underneath the tree.

The intent is to retain the shape in so far as possible, retaining the deodar growth characteristics, but to contain the overall size, as the tree has started to outgrow its position.
