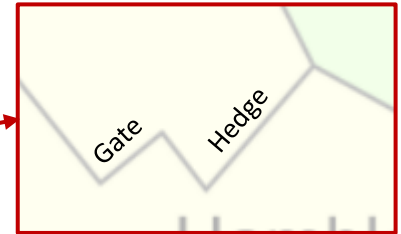


This plan shows the site layout, minus our field.

The current field boundary has a gate set back into the small paddock, and then a hedge running alongside the drive as shown below;



We are applying for change of use for the small strip with the red dashed boundary which bisects the end of the small paddock, in line with the recessed gate. This allows us to site the proposed garage in a way that leaves plenty of parking on the gravel driveway and preserves the view from the house.

These plans result in the loss of 10m of hedging. We will replant a single row of hedging plants, spaced approx. 45cm apart to form a run of native hedging to include Wayfarer, Hazel, Spindle Berry, Crab Apple, Bird Cherry and Field Maple, thereby providing cover, flowers and fruits for wildlife. This is represented by the green line on this plan.
