about this application will be passed to the Secretary of State and
there will be no opportunity to make further representations. Any
owner or tenant wishing to make representations should do so at the
earliest opportunity. The grant of planning permission does not
affect owners' rights to retain or dispose of their property, unless
there is some provision to the contrary in an agreement or in a lease.
The grant of planning permission for non-agricultural development
may affect agricultural tenants' security of tenure.
