T1 - Twin Stemmed Alder - Reduce to the height of the apex of the roof of number 16 and cut back encroachment from the building.  Other trees around this tree have been lost (removed or fallen down). Seeing as this tree is such a tall and leggy tree, it is far more susceptible to being damaged in the wind and the client would like to save the tree. It is also within close proximity to the house.

# T4 - Oak - Prune back encroachment from the building.
