Notification of intention to carry out works to a tree in a Conservation Area**

Proposal:	Fell cherry tree in front corner due to damage to the wall; Fell 3 conifers adjacent to Southgate boundary and street light.

THIS IS A FORMAL DECISION

The City of Wolverhampton as the Local Planning Authority has decided not to make a Tree Preservation Order and hereby advise that you may **proceed** with the above works. The removal of the cherry tree is justified to prevent further damage, and the loss of the conifer trees would not have any adverse impact on the character and appearance of the conservation area.

This advice is valid for a two year period from the date of this letter.
