- ② SPROUTING LOWER BRANCHES FROM EARLIER LIMB REMOVAL GROWING INTO + DAMAGING OUTBUILDING ROOF. TREE ALSO HAS DIEBACK. HIGHER DEAD BRANCHES FALLING ONTO + DAMAGING OUTBUILDING ROOF. TREE IS ASH.
