Good morning Callum,

Below is the response from Simon Glazier – Development Management Team Leader.

As I understand it, the telegraph poles are permitted development, but the operator is required to submit a Regulation 5 Notice to the local planning authority giving one month`s notice. There is no application form.

Administratively it would be easier if they submit it as a single document with an explanatory letter rather than as 22 separate notifications. We could then log it as a TCMAS application – if the works are indeed permitted development we would log it as such and close the case.
