Actions to remove risk of harm to amphibians
Erection of exclusion fence around southern edge of proposed work site - thick plastic membrane erected vertically with the lower side of membrane buried at least 150mm in to the soil and with an 80mm edge of membrane laid horizontally below soil level with disturbed soil then replaced on top of buried lip. Membrane not to be more than 1metre above ground height and is held upright by wooden stakes at intervals.
Quinn Ecology were contacted regarding the erection of this amphibian fence, but because of Covid19, it was felt unnecessary to carry out a face to face site visit and a lengthy telephone conversation was deemed appropriate. A discussion re all aspects of the fence installation was had and the site plan/drawings, provided by Quinn Ecology, were carefully followed.
Removal of potential refugia prior to commencement of works - the wood pile from the wood shed to be removed and placed at least 30m away from construction area. (In actual fact, no refugia remained by the time the works commenced, as all logs had been used).
No construction materials to be stored on the ground, but stored on elevated material such as pallets to prevent amphibians from seeking refuge beneath.
Amphibian ladders (clean plank or broad piece of grooved plastic) to be placed at gentle angle in to any excavation (trench) at the end of each working day, with one end of the plank/plastic in base of excavation and other end at ground level. This will allow any wildlife that has fallen in to excavation an opportunity to escape and avoid predation, stress or dehydration/desiccation.
