Community Infrastructure Levy Regulations (2010) as amended
Regulation 31 - Acknowledgement of the receipt of an
Assumption of Liability Notice.

Proposed Development: Proposed demolition of existing 3 storey building and erection of new apartment block containing 6 no. self contained apartments.
