

Ownership certificate and agricultural declaration

ONE appropriate certificate (A, B, C or D) must be completed, dated and signed

For the following certificates "owner" is a person with a freehold interest or leasehold interest with at least 7 years left to run; "agricultural holding" has the meaning given by reference to the definition of "agricultural tenant" in section 65(8) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

NOTE: You should sign Certificate B, C or D, as appropriate, if you are the sole owner of the land or building to which the application relates but the land is, or is part of, an agricultural holding.
