Note: This planning application has been submitted under the address of 'Tennis Court..etc' as the actual address of The Manor was not listed on the planning portal. The tennis court is on the opposite side of The Manor to the oak tree in question but the location should be clear from the site map.

To crown raise a large mature oak tree by selective removal of lowest primary and low sweeping secondary branches. Branches are close to building behind and cutting back to a standard 1.5m clearance would leave the branches looking stunted and unattractive, and the tree as a whole less aesthetically pleasing. By removing the lower limbs completely to pruning cuts the need to future pruning / wounding is removed and the tree can be left alone. Oaks compartmentalise well and the wound diameter is well within tolerance. The lowest branches are mostly shaded with comparatively few leaves and so their removal with have minimal impact on the trees energy production. The height and form of the tree is such that the visual amenity value of the tree will not be reduced.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

 - o marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - o showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - o adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
