The trees are 6 Ash trees located on the grass bank to the rear of my property, this bank also runs along parallel to the main road (Highfield Road) which runs through this part of the village.

I would like to have all the branches cut off the six trees (Pollard) so as to reduce the overall height of them all. I have had this done previously, some years ago with permission and would like it done again. I have recently had a Tree Surgeon look at them and he could easily identify where the branches were reduced back to before.

The trees have grown very tall since the last time they were done, both my neighbours and myself are concerned that with the seemingly increasing wind strengths we now get, a branch will blown out into the road, onto our garages or onto a conservatory. Or worse an entire tree will be blown down.

Over the last few years, each winter, smaller branches (2 - 3 inches in diameter) have been broken and blown down by the high winds. With the trees at the height they are now they also block out a lot of light from our gardens and rear of the properties spoiling some of the enjoyment we should be getting from them.

My elderly neighbours in particular worry about them during high winds.

You might find it useful to contact an arborist (tree surgeon) for help with defining appropriate work.

 - o marking all trees on the plan, but only numbering those to which you want to carry out work
 - o showing the approximate distance between the application tree(s) and buildings
 - o adding other relevant features on the site (e.g. greenhouse, paths)
